

FOPS 2D Planar system

Row spacing 2m Tree spacing 3m Twin stem 1.35 Uprights 30cm apart (10-12 uprights/tree) 10-12° angle at top

Control Vigour Currently using `55-65% light, system will increase to 90% efficiency


